This conference addresses the evolving landscape of records management in South Africa, where effective information governance has become fundamental to democratic accountability, legal compliance, and institutional continuity. Records management is the backbone of transparent governance, enabling citizens access to information, supporting judicial processes, and preserving the nation's administrative and cultural heritage. Integrating AI and emerging technologies is transforming traditional records management practices through automated classification, intelligent retrieval systems, and predictive analytics, offering unprecedented opportunities to enhance information accessibility and decision-making processes. However, these technological advances present significant ethical and legal challenges for records professionals, including data privacy protection, algorithmic bias in classification systems, digital sovereignty concerns, and maintaining the delicate balance between automated efficiency and human oversight in sensitive governance contexts. Climate change further complicates records management responsibilities, threatening physical records/archives while demanding sustainable digital preservation strategies and raising critical questions about our duty to future generations in safeguarding documentary heritage. This gathering brings together records management professionals, technologists, legal experts, and policymakers to explore how the profession can harness AI's transformative potential while upholding the fundamental principles of records stewardship, ensuring ethical data governance, and building resilient systems that serve South Africa's democratic and developmental aspirations.
